Spring has arrived!

Good news - I have just been reading in a media release by the Ministry of Health on the 30th August that we may be starting to have a decline in cases of influenza, especially in the North Island. Unfortunately there have been 609 hospitilizations of people with pandemic influenza H1N1, with 99 of those needing intensive care. A total of 12 confirmed deaths from swine flu H1N1.

One of the most important things you can do to avoid catching a virus is to wash and dry your hands frequently.
